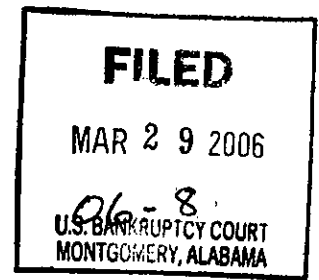

ORDER

The Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts has established a Registry Fee to be assessed for administration of funds held in the registry of the court and placed in interest bearing accounts or instruments; Accordingly,

It is ORDERED that the Clerk of the United States Bankruptcy Court shall deduct from income earned on registry funds invested in interest-bearing accounts or instruments, a fee not exceeding that authorized by the Judicial Conference of the United States and set by the Director of the Administrative Office. The fee shall be withdrawn at the time any distribution is made of the investment principal or at least once annually and shall be deposited in the United States Treasury, without further order of the court. This assessment shall apply to all registry fund investments.
