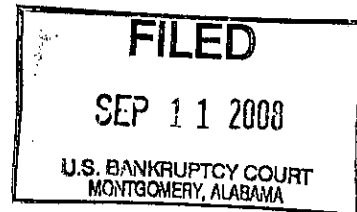

**ORDER ABROGATING
INTERIM BANKRUPTCY RULES**

On October 17, 2005, this court, upon the recommendation of the Committee on Rules of Practice and Procedures of the Judicial Conference of the United States, adopted Interim Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure. The Interim Rules were designed to implement the substantive and procedural changes mandated by the *Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2005* (Pub. L. No. 109-8).

New rules and amendments to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure will take effect on December 1, 2008, and will supersede the Interim Rules. According, it is

ORDERED that the Interim Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure are abrogated effective midnight, November 30, 2008.
