AMENDED ORDER GOVERNING PROCEDURES IN CASES UNDER
CHAPTER 13—ALL SETTINGS

Effective January 1, 2019, filings shall be made in cases no later than 5:00 PM on the fourth full business day prior to the day in which such case will be called, not counting the day of the hearing. "Filings" affected by this Order include amendments to plans, schedules and statements, as well as objections, motions, and responses of all kinds. The purpose of this Order is to give the Chapter 13 Trustee and the Court three full business days to consider filings in advance of a hearing. Counsel should not assume that cases in which filings are made after the deadline set forth herein will be continued. Counsel should keep in mind the provisions of LBR 3015-2—providing for the dismissal of a Chapter 13 case at confirmation when the case is not ready to proceed. Cases that have been previously continued are subject to dismissal in instances where a tardy amendment or other filing is made.
