ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER



EFFECTIVE JANUARY 3, 2022 THROUGH JANUARY 31, 2022, ALL HEARINGS NOTICED FOR THE BANKRUPTCY COURT IN THE MIDDLE DISTRICT OF ALABAMA WILL BE HELD TELEPHONICALLY ONLY. THIS APPLIES TO ALL DIVISIONS AND ALL LOCATIONS.

In-person appearances at the courthouse by parties or their counsel are prohibited unless specifically ordered otherwise on a case-by-case basis.
