ORDER APPROVING PROCEDURES FOR CHAPTER 7 TRUSTEE'S DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS RECEIVED AFTER APPROVAL OF TRUSTEE'S FINAL REPORT

In limited instances, chapter 7 trustees receive additional estate funds after the trustee's final report has been approved by the Court. To address funds received after approval of the trustee's final report, the Court is of the opinion that the following procedures shall govern distribution of funds received.

It is ORDERED that, if a chapter 7 trustee receives estate funds totaling \$1,000.00 or less after the trustee's final report was approved, the chapter 7 trustee shall redistribute the funds to other creditors according to the priorities set forth in 11 U.S.C. §§ 507 and 726 and in accordance with Fed. R. Bankr. P. 3010 and 3011, without the need for further notice or further Court approval, provided the following conditions are met:

- (a) No objection was filed to the trustee's final report; and,
- (b) The redistribution does not result in new classes of creditors receiving funds.
